More than 110 published papers in refereed journals, two books, more than 2300 citations. Coordinator of the joint M.Sc. program "Micropaleontology-Biostratigraphy" in NKUA. President of the Hellenic Committee for Paleontology and Stratigraphy of the Geological Society of Greece and Member of the Steering Committee of MECLIVAR network (Mediterranean Climate Variability and Predictability).
